This archipelago, containing the only mid-ocean, granitic islands on the planet and certainly known to the early Arab seafarers, was a favourite pirate haunt before being colonized by the French in 1769 and the British in 1814. Seychelles became an independent republic within the Commonwealth in 1976.

Seychelles has also been blessed with an extraordinarily diverse blend of mid-ocean granitic islands, coral atolls, and reef islands. Strung like jewels on threads of ivory surf, each one possesses its very own distinct character and charm, inviting Island-hoppers to experience their variety either by fast catamaran ferry, the inter-island service of Air Seychelles, or by helicopter.

Variety exists in more than just islands. Today, Seychelles continues to be a sanctuary for a unique array of flora and fauna that includes some of the most exotic and rarest specimens on earth. Counted among their ranks are





the Coco-de-mer, the world's heaviest nut that appears in the perfect form of the female pelvis, the Seychelles Black Parrot that inhabits the primaeval vallée de Mai, the Seychelles Magpie robin that has been rescued from the brink of extinction and the Jellyfish tree, of which only a handful remain in existence.

Throughout the islands are to be found unparalleled opportunities for sailing on bare-boat or skippered yachts, deep-sea and fly-fishing, as well as a broad diversity of dive experiences. Seychelles also boasts excellent ecoholidays, walks & trails, spa & wellness vacations, island-hopping and golf.

Long known as the islands of love, Seychelles offers a naturally romantic backdrop for weddings and honeymoons, as well as being an enticing destination for select incentive groups and the elite of the business world.
